FOURTEEN-year-old US
mountain climber Richard
Garret, became yesterday the
youngest person to climb
Aconcagua, the highest peak
in the American continent.
Richard was member of a
team of veteran climbers.
The group included the boy's
father, Ronald Garret who
had reached the mountain
peak on three previous occa-
sions. The previous "youn-
gest-ever" record was
previously held by Alfredo
Magnani who reached the
top of Aconcagua about 35
years ago when he was 17
